3	procedure; to provide for processes to review agency rules; to require agencies to
4	conduct periodic hearings to have public comment on rules; and to require reports
5	to the appropriate committees of the legislature regarding such comment; and to
6	provide for related matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 49:953(C) and 968(K) and (L) are hereby amended and reenacted to
9	read as follows:
10	§953. Procedure for adoption of rules; agency rule review
11	* * *
12	C.(1) An interested person may petition an agency requesting the adoption,
13	amendment, or repeal of a rule. Each agency shall prescribe by rule the form for
14	petitions and the procedure for their submission, considerations, and disposition.
15	Within ninety days after submission of a petition, the agency shall either deny the
16	petition in writing, stating reasons for the denial, or shall initiate rule making
17	rulemaking proceedings in accordance with this Chapter. Each agency with an
18	appropriated operating budget of five million dollars or more shall include on its
19	website a description of the procedure for submitting petitions in accordance with
20	this Paragraph.
21	(2)(a) At least once prior to January 1, 2020, and at least once during every
22	six-year period thereafter, each agency subject to Paragraph (1) of this Subsection

which engages in rulemaking shall conduct a public hearing for the purpose of allowing any interested person the opportunity to comment on any rule of the agency which the person believes is contrary to law, outdated, unnecessary, overly complex, or burdensome. The agency shall publish notice of the meeting in the Louisiana Register, give notice of the meeting electronically to the appropriate legislative oversight committees, and shall provide notice of the meeting to all persons who have made timely request of the agency for notice of rule changes, all no later than thirty days prior to the meeting.

- (b) The notice of the meeting shall contain:
- (i) The name of the agency.

- (ii) The purpose of the meeting.
- (iii) The time and place of the meeting.
- (iv) The process for requesting reasonable accommodations for persons with disabilities.
- (v) The name and contact information of the person within the agency to whom interested persons should direct their views regarding the agency's rules, if in writing, and the deadline for submission of written comments.
- submissions concerning its rules. The agency shall advise persons who provide oral comments that in order to be submitted to the legislative oversight committees, comments must be submitted to the agency in writing. The agency shall issue a response to each submission describing the principal advantages and disadvantages of the rule changes suggested in the submission. In addition, the agency may prepare a statement explaining the basis and rationale for the rule in question identifying the data and evidence upon which the rule is based. All such statements and responses to submissions shall be furnished to the respective legislative oversight committees in the manner provided by R.S. 49:968(K) and shall be made available to interested persons as soon as possible but no later than one day following their submission to the appropriate legislative oversight committees.

Review of agency rules; fees 2 3 K.(1) Each year, no later than thirty days prior to the beginning of the regular 4 session of the legislature, each agency which has proposed the adoption, amendment, 5 or repeal of any rule or the adoption, increase, or decrease of any fee during the 6 previous year, shall submit a report to the appropriate committees as provided for in 7 Subsection B of this Section. This report shall contain a statement of the action 8 taken by the agency with respect to adoption, amendment, or repeal of each rule 9 proposed for adoption, amendment, or repeal during the previous year and a report of the action taken by the agency with respect to any proposed fee adoption, increase, 10 11 or decrease during the previous year. 12 (2) The report required by Paragraph (1) of this Subsection shall also contain 13 a recitation of each petition and submission, if any, received by the agency pursuant 14 to R.S. 49:953(C) during the previous calendar year and the agency's response to 15 each petition and submission, if any were received. 16 L. After submission of the report <u>required by Subsection K of this Section</u> to 17 the standing committee, a public hearing may be held by the committee for the 18 purpose of reviewing the report with representatives of the proposing agency. 19 20 Section 2.
