2	To enact R.S. 18:501(C), relative to the Louisiana Election Code; to provide with respect to
3	the withdrawal and election of candidates; and to provide for related matters.
4	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
5	Section 1. R.S. 18:501(C) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
6	§501. Procedure for withdrawal
7	* * *
8	C. Notwithstanding the provisions of Subsections A and B of this Section,
9	if there are only two candidates remaining in a primary or general election for
10	a public office, the secretary of state shall accept a notice of withdrawal that is
11	filed prior to 4:30 p.m. on the second day prior to the election. The candidate
12	remaining after the withdrawal is declared elected by the people.
13	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
14	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
15	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
16	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
17	effective on the day following such approval.
