9	Angeles and created an international organization designed to encourage young people to
10	take a leadership role in society and become catalysts for change; and
11	WHEREAS, John Honeycutt, son of Stephanie and David Honeycutt, attended the
12	2018 Louisiana Hugh O'Brian Youth Leadership Seminar; and
13	WHEREAS, the Louisiana HOBY Leadership program hosted 140 high school
14	sophomores who represented their respective high schools throughout the state of Louisiana;

16	WHEREAS, the HOBY World Leadership Congress is held every year and brings
17	together over 400 young leaders from the United States, Puerto Rico, and 11 other countries
18	for a weeklong intensive educational leadership conference; and
