<u>Existing law</u> requires each physician who performs or induces an abortion which does not result in a live birth to insure that the remains of the child are disposed of by interment or cremation.

<u>New law</u> provides an exception to the requirements of <u>existing law</u> in cases of abortions induced with medications when the evacuation of any human remains occurs at a later time, neither in the presence of the inducing physician nor at the facility in which the physician administered the inducing medications.

<u>New law</u> requires the La. Department of Health to promulgate all rules as are necessary to facilitate the transfer and burial of aborted human remains in a manner consistent with the transfer and burial of unclaimed human remains.

Effective upon signature of governor (May 15, 2018).
