Existing law requires that in order to become licensed by the La. Board of Chiropractic Examiners, an applicant shall hold a baccalaureate degree from a college or university approved by an accrediting agency of the U.S. Department of Education.

<u>New law</u> retains <u>existing law</u> and provides that the accrediting agency may also include the successor of the U.S. Department of Education or its foreign equivalent.

Effective August 1, 2018.
