<u>Existing law</u> authorizes the commissioner of conservation to levy certain penalties for violations of the pipeline safety provisions of law. Requires a notice of the violation and an opportunity for a hearing. <u>Prior law</u> authorized the imposition of a penalty not to exceed \$10,000 per day for each violation with a maximum penalty not to exceed \$500,000 for any related series of violations.

<u>New law</u> increases the maximums to \$200,000 per day of violation and a maximum of \$2 million for any related series of violations.

Effective August 1, 2018.
