Existing law provides that the La. Dept. of Health (LDH) shall assess each emergency ground service provider a percentage fee.

<u>Prior law</u> provided that the maximum fee allowable in any year shall not exceed three and one-half percent of the annual net operating revenue of the emergency ground ambulance service provider.

<u>New law</u> provides that the maximum fee allowable in any year shall not exceed the percentage of net patient service revenues permitted by federal regulation pursuant to 42 CFR 433.68 as determined by (LDH).

<u>Prior law</u> required (LDH) to publish in the official state journal the total amount of the fee assessment and the corresponding applicable percentage of net operating revenue that will be applied to assess the emergency ground service providers.

<u>New law</u> repeals this requirement.

Effective August 1, 2018.
