<u>Existing law</u> authorizes a local governing authority to protect the public health, safety, and welfare by licensing, controlling, and regulating ambulance services.

<u>Existing law</u> authorizes a local governing authority to regulate rates charged for ambulance services in accordance with federal law relative to medical reimbursement. <u>New law</u> provides that if such rates are set by a local governing authority and the ambulance service has not entered a contract for alternative reimbursement, those rates shall be the minimum allowable charge under any health insurance policy.

Effective August 1, 2018.
