**Abstract:** Repeals provisions allowing a retiree of the Firefighters' Retirement System (FRS) who marries after retirement to name that spouse as a beneficiary.

<u>Present law provides</u> for optional benefit allowances for FRS members and designated beneficiaries. Such options include providing for a beneficiary to receive retirement benefits after the death of the member.

Proposed law retains present law.

<u>Present law</u> further provides that an FRS member who was single at the time of retirement but who married and has been married for at least 12 months may select such a benefit option for his spouse.

<u>Proposed law</u> repeals <u>present law</u>.
