DISTRICTS/COMMUNICATIONS: Provides relative to per diem received by the board of commissioners of Tangipahoa Communications District Number 1

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 33:9103(F), relative to Tangipahoa Communications District Number 1; to  
3 provide relative to the per diem paid to members of the board of commissioners; and  
4 to provide for related matters.

5 Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published  
6 as provided by Article III, Section 13 of the Constitution of  
7 Louisiana.

8 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

9 Section 1. R.S. 33:9103(F) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

10 §9103. Board of commissioners; membership; qualifications and terms; powers;  
11 parish governing authority as district governing authority

12 \* \* \*

13 F. The members of the board of commissioners of Tangipahoa  
14 Communications District Number 1 shall each receive a per diem of fifty dollars for  
15 attending meetings of the board, for a maximum of one regular meeting per month  
16 and six special meetings per year. Per diem paid pursuant to this Subsection shall  
17 be paid out of the funds of the district.

**Abstract:** Provides for per diem for the board of commissioners of Tangipahoa Communications District Number 1.

Present law authorizes the governing authority of any parish to create communications districts to provide 911 service. Further authorizes the parish governing authority to appoint a board of commissioners composed of seven members to govern its affairs when such district is created wholly within a single parish.

Proposed law provides that the members of the board of commissioners of Tangipahoa Communications District Number 1 shall each receive a per diem of \$50 for attending a meeting of the board for a maximum of one regular meeting per month and six special meetings per year. Further provides that per diem paid pursuant to proposed law shall be paid out of the funds of the district.
