<u>Present law</u> requires an applicant for the certified medication attendant drug administration training course to be a citizen of the United States and a resident of Louisiana. <u>Proposed law</u> clarifies and expands the citizenship requirement to allow for a citizen of the United States, a United States national, or an alien lawfully admitted for permanent residency in the United States. <u>Proposed law</u> repeals the state residency requirement. <u>Proposed law</u> retains the additional eligibility requirements for acceptance into the drug administration course set forth in present law.

Proposed law makes technical corrections to the eligibility requirements retained from present law.

Effective August 1, 2019.
