APPROPRIATIONS/SUPPLEML: Makes supplemental appropriations for Fiscal Year 2018-2019

1 AN ACT

2 To appropriate funds and to make certain reductions from certain sources to be allocated to  
3 designated agencies and purposes in specific amounts for the making of  
4 supplemental appropriations and reductions for said agencies and purposes for Fiscal  
5 Year 2018-2019; to provide for an effective date; and to provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. The following sums are hereby appropriated from the sources specified for  
8 the purpose of making supplemental appropriations for Fiscal Year 2018-2019. Reductions  
9 are denoted in parentheses.

12 Payable out of Federal Funds to the Soil and  
13 Water Conservation Program for conservation  
14 measures \$ 600,000

16 **10-360 OFFICE OF CHILDREN AND FAMILY SERVICES**

17 The commissioner of administration is hereby authorized and directed to adjust the  
18 means of finance for the Division of Family Support Program, as contained in Act No. 2  
19 of the 2018 Second Extraordinary Session of the Legislature, by reducing the  
20 appropriation out of the State General Fund by Fees and Self Generated Revenue by  
21 (\$3,025,301).

12 appropriation out of the State General Fund (Direct) by (\$489,585).

13 Payable out of the State General Fund (Direct)  
14 to the Louisiana School for the Visually Impaired  
15 Program for expenses \$ 489,585

16 **19-655 LOUISIANA SPECIAL EDUCATION CENTER**

17 Payable out of the State General Fund by  
18 Interagency Transfers to the LSEC Education  
19 Program for building repairs \$ 325,000

20 **19-657 JIMMY D. LONG, SR LOUISIANA SCHOOL FOR MATH, SCIENCE,**  
21 **AND THE ARTS**

22 The commissioner of administration is hereby authorized and directed to adjust the  
23 means of finance for the Louisiana Virtual School Program, as contained in Act No. 2 of  
24 the 2018 Second Extraordinary Session of the Legislature, by reducing the appropriation  
25 out of the State General Fund by Fees and Self Generated Revenue by (\$250,000).

26 **19-658 THRIVE ACADEMY**

27 The commissioner of administration is hereby authorized and directed to adjust the  
28 means of finance for the Instruction Program, as contained in Act No. 2 of the 2018  
29 Second Extraordinary Session of the Legislature, by reducing the appropriation out of

37 Second Extraordinary Session of the Legislature, by reducing the appropriation out of the  
38 State General Fund by Statutory Dedications out of the Louisiana Charter School Start-up  
39 Loan Fund by (\$200,000).

40 **DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION**

41 **19-699 SPECIAL SCHOOL DISTRICT**

42 The commissioner of administration is hereby authorized and directed to adjust the  
43 means of finance for the Instruction Program, as contained in Act No. 2 of the 2018

1 Second Extraordinary Session of the Legislature, by reducing the appropriation out of the  
2 State General Fund by Fees and Self Generated Revenue by (\$700,000).

3 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not  
4 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without  
5 signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of  
6 Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this  
7 Act shall become effective on the day following such approval.

Appropriates supplemental funding and provides for means of financing substitutions and other budgetary adjustments for Fiscal Year 2018-2019. Provides for net increases (decreases) as follows: State General Fund (Direct) by \$0; Interagency Transfers by \$141,614; Fees & Self-generated Revenues by (\$3,975,301); Statutory Dedications by (\$2,527,716); and Federal Funds by \$1,016,418.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
