WHEREAS, he has argued before the Louisiana Court of Appeal for the Third Circuit, the United States Fifth Circuit Court of Appeals, and successfully before the Louisiana Supreme Court; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Cravins has served as adjunct professor at Southern University Law
