Provides that <u>present law</u> does not apply to certain courts.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and, relative to the Juvenile Court for Caddo Parish, provides that any person employed on or before August 1, 2019, as an official court reporter or deputy official court reporter by a court of record that uses electronic or audio recording equipment shall be certified as long as he remains employed by that court in such capacity.
