Abstract: Creates a "Combat Veteran" military honor license plate.

<u>Proposed law</u> creates the "Combat Veteran" license plate for persons that present certification from the U.S. Dept. of Veteran Affairs or the La. Dept. of Veterans Affairs showing that the applicant is a combat veteran.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for the creation, qualification, issuance, design, fees, distribution, transfer, and rule promulgation related to the military honor license plate.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the secretary of the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections to adopt rules relative to the implementation of the military honor license plate including the transfer of the license plate to the surviving spouse and the disposition of the military honor license plate.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the office of motor vehicles to create the special prestige plate provided for in <u>proposed law</u> when the applicable statutory provisions are met and its system is updated to accommodate new plates.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Transportation</u>, <u>Highways and Public Works</u> to the <u>original</u> bill:

1. Require the Dept. of Public Safety, office of motor vehicles, to create the special prestige license plate provided for in this instrument when the applicable statutory provisions are met and their system is updated to accommodate the creation of new plates.

The House Floor Amendments to the engrossed bill:

1. Make a technical change.
