1	United States Navy during World War II; and
12	WHEREAS, he was a practicing attorney for over sixty-five years; Marc was a
13	lifelong, avid sportsman and pilot and a dedicated wildlife conservationist and geologist; and
4	WHEREAS, ever active in his community, in 1986 he was named Avoyellean of the
15	Year for his involvement in the creation of five wildlife management and wildlife refuge
16	areas in Louisiana and his role on several volunteer boards; the award is presented annually
17	to an Avoyelles Parish resident for his countless, unselfish deeds; for many years he
18	faithfully supported the Louisiana Wildlife Federation, Louisiana Forestry Association,
