<u>Proposed law</u> provides that no professional or occupational licensing board or commission shall:

- (1) Enter into a consent decree with a licensee, permittee, or certificate holder if such decree contains a nondisparagement clause. Such nondisparagement clause contained in a consent decree is contrary to public policy of this state and shall be null, void, and unenforceable.
- (2) Initiate any disciplinary actions against a licensee, permittee, or certificate holder for providing testimony or records to a legislative body.

Proposed law defines "legislative body".

Effective August 1, 2019.
