Abstract: Adds to the enumerated list, certain offenses that will prohibit individuals from obtaining employment as a licensed ambulance personnel or nonlicensed person.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the prohibition of employers from hiring licensed ambulance personnel or nonlicensed person when they have been convicted of certain criminal offenses enumerated within <u>present law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> removes a reference to R.S. 14:62.1, which has been repealed.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds the crime of identity theft to the list of prohibited offenses that would prohibit employment as a licensed ambulance personnel or nonlicensed person.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds the crime of abuse of persons with infirmities through electronic means to the list of prohibited offenses that would prohibit employment as a licensed ambulance personnel or nonlicensed person.
