**Abstract:** Requires the commissioner of alcohol and tobacco control to suspend or revoke dealer permits for alcoholic beverages when the dealer fails to pay taxes due to the state.

<u>Present law</u> requires the commissioner to suspend or revoke any alcohol permit of a dealer that fails to pay any sales taxes due to the state.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and further requires the suspension or revocation of any permit of a dealer that fails to pay any of the following taxes:

- (1) Taxes on beverages of high alcoholic content
- (2) Taxes on beverages of low alcoholic content
- (3) Tobacco taxes
- (4) Withholding taxes
- (5) La. Stadium and Exposition District hotel occupancy taxes
- (6) Ernest N. Morial New Orleans Exhibition Hall Authority taxes

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
