6	Rule 5.7. Designation of or referral to certain former senators
7	A. A former senator may be designated or referred to as "Senator
8	Retired, District No." followed by the number of the Senatorial District
9	represented.
10	B. "Former senator" as used in this Rule, means a former senator who
11	served in the Senate and, because of this service, was prohibited by Article III,
12	Section 4(E) of the Constitution of Louisiana from being elected to the Senate.

<u>Proposed Senate rule</u> provides that a former senator may be designated or referred to as "Senator Retired, District No." followed by the number of the Senatorial District represented. Defines "former senator" as a former senator who served in the Senate and, because of this service, was prohibited by Article III, Section 4(E) of the La. Constitution from being elected to the Senate.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

<u>Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Senate and Governmental Affairs to the original bill</u>

1. Changes the applicability of being considered a "former senator" from senators who have served 12 years to senators who have served for any period of time.
