Mayor's court; town of Livingston; court costs 6 7 Notwithstanding R.S. 33:441(A) or any other provision of law to the 8 contrary, the mayor of the town of Livingston may impose court costs not to 9 exceed fifty dollars for each offense, as defined by ordinance, on any defendant 10 convicted of a violation of a municipal ordinance. 11 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not 12 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature 13 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If 14 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval. 15

<u>Present law</u>, relative to mayor's court, authorizes the mayor to impose court costs not to exceed \$30 for each offense on any defendant convicted of a violation of a municipal ordinance.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that notwithstanding <u>present law</u>, the mayor of the town of Livingston may impose court costs not to exceed \$50 dollars for each offense on any defendant convicted of a violation of a municipal ordinance.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
