12 K.(1) Notwithstanding the provisions of Subsection A of this 13 Section, there is hereby established a special account within the Proprietary School Student Protection Fund to be known as the Proprietary School 14 15 Student Records and Administration Account, hereafter in this Subsection 16 referred to as the "administration account". Any balance in the Proprietary School Student Protection Fund on July 1, 2000, that exceeds eight hundred 17 18 thousand dollars, as provided in Subsection F of this Section, shall be deposited into the administration account. All interest earned on the fund 19 20 after July 1, 2000, shall be deposited in the administration account. All deposits made to the Proprietary School Student Protection Fund after July 21 1, 2000, shall be made in accordance with the provisions of this Section. 22 (2) Amounts from the administration account shall be pledged and 23

24 dedicated solely and exclusively for costs associated with board functions as
 25 they relate to the administration of proprietary schools and for the creation
 26 of a digital student records management system."
