DIGEST 2019 Regular Session

White

<u>Present law</u> prohibits contracts or agreements which restrain anyone from exercising a lawful profession, trade, or business of any kind, unless specifically exempt by <u>present law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and prohibits noncompete and nonsolicitation contract clauses that restrict any physician, advanced practice registered nurse, nurse practitioner, or physician assistant from practicing, upon termination of employment or independent contractor agreement, for a five-year continuous period with the same employer or affiliate in the same geographical area.

Effective August 1, 2019.
