2 To amend and reenact R.S. 17:71.2(A), relative to the size of school boards; to provide with 3 regard to the maximum and minimum size of school boards; and to provide for 4 related matters. 5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 6 Section 1. R.S. 17:71.2(A) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows: 7 §71.2. Maximum and minimum size of boards; four-year concurrent terms 8 A. In accomplishing the reapportionment authorized by this Subpart, each 9 of said school boards board may, by majority vote of said the board as presently 10 constituted, reestablish itself with not less than five nor more than fifteen members. 11 or the number presently authorized for that school board, whichever is the greater. 12 Whenever the size of a school board is to be changed by reapportionment, the school 13 board may submit the proposition of size to the people. 14

Abstract: Provides relative to maximum and minimum size of school boards.

<u>Present law</u> authorizes a school board, during the reapportionment process, to reestablish its membership with at least five but not more than 15 members. Excepts a school board "presently authorized" to have a greater number from the maximum on the number of members. <u>Proposed law</u> removes this exception and otherwise retains <u>present law</u>.

The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Education</u> to the <u>original</u> bill:

1. Remove <u>present law</u> exception allowing a school board to reapportion itself with greater than 15 members under certain circumstances.
