Fannin

<u>Present law</u> provides for exemptions from sales and use tax for purchases of feed, seed, fertilizer, and fuel by commercial farmers.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for exemptions from sales and use tax for purchases of feed, seed, and fertilizer by student farmers.

<u>Proposed law</u> defines student farmer as a person who is under the age of 23 and who is enrolled in FFA, 4-H, or a similar student agricultural program.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the secretary of revenue to promulgate rules in conjunction with the LSU Ag. Center to determine who meets the definitions of small farmer and student farmer.

<u>Present law</u> provides the exclusive list of state sales and use tax exemptions applicable until July 1, 2025.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds the exemption for purchases of feed, seed, and fertilizer by student farmers to the list of applicable state sales and use tax exemptions.

Effective August 1, 2019.
