**Abstract:** Provides alternative means of verifying that a person is 21 years of age or older for the purpose of selling or serving alcoholic beverages, and prohibits certain acts on the licensed premises of a person permitted to sell alcoholic beverages at retail to consumers.

<u>Present law</u> prohibits a person holding a retail dealer's permit, and any agent, associate, employee, representative, or servant of such person, to do or permit certain acts on or about the licensed premises.

<u>Proposed law</u> extends the application of the <u>present law</u> prohibitions to persons permitted to sell alcoholic beverages at retail to consumers.

<u>Present law</u> further provides for a list of certain types of identification to be used for verifying the age of persons when selling or serving alcoholic beverages.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains the <u>present law</u> list and authorizes the use of a real-time age verification system authorized by the commissioner of ATC to verify the age of persons when selling or serving alcoholic beverages.
