HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 145

ENVIRONMENT: Requests the Department of Environmental Quality to study the effects of evolving 5G technology

1	A RESOLUTION
2	To urge and request the Department of Environmental Quality to study the effects of
3	evolving 5G technology and report its findings to the House Committee on Natural
4	Resources and Environment no later than sixty days prior to the convening of the
5	2020 Regular Session of the Legislature.
6	WHEREAS, Fifth generation, or 5G technology, is intended to greatly increase
7	device capability and connectivity but also may pose risks to the environment due to
8	increased radio-frequency radiation exposure; and
9	WHEREAS, a study is necessary to examine the advantages and risks associated with
10	5G technology, with a focus on the environmental impact and potential related effects; and
11	WHEREAS, peer-reviewed studies on this topic show the potential for wide-range
12	effects; and
13	WHEREAS, 5G technology requires small cellular towers to be placed a short
14	distance apart, closer than existing towers, at telephone pole height, and will operate in
15	conjunction with the 3G and 4G technology infrastructure; and
16	WHEREAS, the insurance industry may have placed exclusions in policies to exempt
17	damage caused by this technology; and
18	WHEREAS, certain manufacturers provide warnings to consumers regarding the
19	reception of devices using this technology; and
20	WHEREAS, input is needed from the technological and other communities as well
21	as persons involved with developing 5G technology.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
Legislature of Louisiana does hereby urge and request the Department of Environmental
Quality to study the effects of evolving 5G technology and report its findings to the House
Committee on Natural Resources and Environment no later than sixty days prior to the
convening of the 2020 Regular Session of the Legislature.
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the
secretary of the Department of Environmental Quality.
