A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To commend retired United States Army Colonel Harry J. Montgomery on his many accomplishments.

WHEREAS, Harry J. Montgomery served for thirty-seven and one-half years in the United States Army, retiring with the rank of colonel in October 1989, and during his service held commands at the brigade, battalion, and company levels; and

WHEREAS, Colonel Montgomery's last active assignment was Director of Intelligence and Security, Adjutant General's staff; and

WHEREAS, he is now Chairman of the Retiree Council Fort Polk which covers military retirees in Louisiana, Mississippi, and seven southeast Texas counties; a member of the employer support of the United States Army National Guard and United States Army National Reserve for southwest Louisiana, and Chairman of the Armed Forces Committee for the city of Sulphur; and
