9	(a) The privilege is asserted for a fraudulent purpose.
10	(b) The portion of the voluntary environmental audit report is not subject to
11	the privilege under this Subsection.
12	(c) The portion of the voluntary environmental audit report shows evidence
13	of noncompliance with an environmental or health and safety law and appropriate
14	efforts to achieve compliance with the law were not promptly initiated and pursued
15	with reasonable diligence after discovery of noncompliance."
