15	B.(1) Notwithstanding any other provisions of law to the contrary, the sales
16	tax levied by the state of Louisiana and its political subdivisions whose boundaries
17	are coterminous with those of the state shall not apply to the first two thousand five
18	hundred dollars of the sales price or cost price of any consumer purchases of tangible
19	personal property that occur on the first consecutive Friday and Saturday of August
20	last consecutive Saturday and Sunday of July each year.
21	(2) Any political subdivision authorized by the constitution and laws of this
22	state to levy and impose a sales and use tax may, by ordinance or resolution, apply
23	this exemption to the sales and use tax levied and imposed by the political
24	subdivision. To participate in the annual sales tax holiday, the governing authority
25	of the political subdivision shall submit a copy of the ordinance or resolution to the
26	secretary of revenue no later than sixty days before the beginning of the sales tax
27	<u>holiday.</u>
28	(3) For purposes of this Section, "consumer purchases" shall mean purchases
29	of items of tangible personal property other than: vehicles
30	(a) Vehicles subject to license and title.
31	(b) Consumer purchases shall not include the purchase of meals Meals
32	furnished for consumption on the premises where purchased, including to-go orders.
33	(c) Items not purchased from a physical retail location in the state.
34	(d) Food for home consumption and prescription drugs.

36	§305.58. Exemption; annual sales tax holiday; hurricane-preparedness items or
37	supplies; dates; restrictions
38	A.(1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the sales
39	and use tax levied by the state of Louisiana and its political subdivisions shall not
40	apply to the first one two thousand five hundred dollars of the sales price of
41	purchases of hurricane-preparedness items or supplies as defined in this Subsection
42	that occur during an eligible tax exemption period.

44	(b) For purposes of this Section, "eligible tax exemption period" shall mean
45	purchases of hurricane-preparedness items or supplies during the last weekend in

11	B.(1) Notwithstanding any other provisions of law to the contrary, the sales
12	and use tax levied by the state of Louisiana and its political subdivisions shall not
13	apply to the first two thousand five hundred dollars of the sales price or cost price
14	of any consumer purchases of firearms, ammunition, and hunting supplies that occur
15	each calendar year on the first consecutive Friday through Sunday of September <u>last</u>
16 17	<u>consecutive Saturday and Sunday of July</u> . (2) For purposes of this Section, "consumer purchases" shall mean purchases
18	by individuals of firearms, ammunition, and hunting supplies not for business
19	purposes. Consumer purchases shall not include the purchase of animals for the use
20	of hunting or items not purchased from a physical retail location in the state.
21	(3) For the purposes of this Section, "hunting supplies" shall mean purchases
22	of any tangible personal property for the use of hunting, including but not limited to
23 24	archery, off-road vehicles, and vessels such as ATVs, airboats, and pirogues
24 25	accessories, animal feed, apparel, shoes, bags, float tubes, binoculars, tools, firearm and archery cases, firearm and archery accessories, range finders, knives, decoys,
26	treestands, blinds, chairs, optics, hearing protection and enhancements, holsters,
27	belts, slings, and miscellaneous gear, and nontitled vehicles and vessels.
