- On page 2, at the end of line 24, insert "For any request made by providers utilizing
- 14 <u>electronic health records with capabilities, the notice may be sent electronically."</u>

- On page 2, at the beginning of line 25, change "(c)" to "(d)"
- 17 <u>AMENDMENT NO. 6</u>

- 19 "Section 2. This Act shall become effective on January 1, 2020. However, the
- 20 provisions regarding notices that are sent in a manner other than electronically, shall not be
- 21 enforceable against any health insurance issuer or health maintenance organization for acts
- taking place prior to July 1, 2020."
