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Increases the salary of the district attorney

**Present law** provides that district attorneys statewide are to receive an annual salary of \$50,000 payable monthly and that assistant district attorneys statewide are to receive an annual salary of \$45,000 payable monthly.

**Proposed law** increases the salary of the district attorney to \$52,500 beginning July 1, 2020, and to \$55,000 beginning July 1, 2021. **Proposed law** increases the salary of the assistant district attorneys to \$47,500 beginning July 1, 2020, and to \$50,000 beginning July 1, 2021. Effective July 1, 2019.

## **EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

**Proposed law** will significantly increase SGF personal services expenditures for District Attorneys and Assistant District Attorneys by increasing the annual salary payable by the state to district attorneys (DAs) and assistant district attorneys (ADAs) by \$2,500 on July 1, 2020, and DAs and ADAs by \$5,000 (an additional \$2,500 each) on July 1, 2021.

R.S. 16:51 provides for 579 assistant district attorneys (ADA) in the forty-two districts. These 579 ADAs combined with the 42 district attorneys yields 621 total positions that would be eligible for a \$2,500 increase in FY 21 for a total salary expenditure increase of \$1,552,500 (621 \* \$2,500). The additional Medicare cost for this salary increase is approximately \$22,511 (\$1,552,500 \* 1.45%). The additional retirement costs for this salary increase based on the FY 20 actuary recommended employer contribution rate of 4% is approximately \$62,100 (\$1,552,500 \* 4%), for a total personal services expenditure increase of \$1,637,111 (\$1.55 M + \$22,511 + \$62,100) in FY 21. The costs reflected in this fiscal note for FY 22, FY 23, and FY 24 are associated with the additional personal services expenditure increases for DAs and ADAs (an additional \$2,500 each, effective 7/1/21).

## REVENUE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
