AN ACT

2	To provide relative to state highways; to provide for the addition and erection of certain
3	signs on the Louisiana welcome signs on Interstate 10 at the Texas and Mississippi
4	state lines; to name a portion of U.S. Highway 90 the "Governor Kathleen Babineaux
5	Blanco Highway"; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. The department shall add "Home of the Who Dat Nation" signs to the
8	Louisiana welcome signs on Interstate 10 in Louisiana at the Texas and Mississippi state
9	lines and in downtown New Orleans at the exit to the Superdome.
10	Section 2. U.S. Highway 90 from its intersection with Interstate 10 in Lafayette to
11	its intersection with Louisiana Highway No. 308 in Raceland is hereby named the "Governor
12	Kathleen Babineaux Blanco Highway".
13	Section 3. The Department of Transportation and Development is hereby directed
14	to erect and maintain appropriate signs provided local or private monies are received by the

department equal to the department's actual costs for material, fabrication, mounting posts,
and installation of each sign, not to exceed the sum of one thousand one hundred dollars per
sign.
