To amend and reenact R.S. 44:415, relative to the records management program at the division of archives, records management, and history within the Department of State; to provide for the centralized document conversion center for the state; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 44:415 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

§415. Centralized microfilm service imaging and preservation services

The microfilm imaging and preservation services section of the records management program of the division shall be the centralized microfilm document conversion center for the state. All state agencies lacking existing internally established microfilming paper conversion systems of their own, and those state agencies whose equipment or facilities are no longer adequate to meet the agency's need, shall contract with the division for microfilming conversion services or shall obtain division approval for any such a conversion contract with any other vendor or purchase of any other conversion system. All microfilming records produced by state agency microfilming conversion systems shall comply with standards established by the division in accordance with R.S. 44:405(A)(3). This provision

shall not be applicable to any state agency where it can be demonstrated to be more economically feasible to continue the microfilming within the agency.
