PHARMACEUTICALS EN NO IMPACT See Note Provides relative to prescription monitoring information. (8/1/19)

<u>Present law</u> authorizes the LA Board of Pharmacy (LBP) to provide prescription information to prescription monitoring programs in other states. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and expands the LBP's ability to provide prescription monitoring information to electronic health information systems and pharmacy information systems in other states, territories, federal districts, and federal jurisdictions. <u>Proposed law</u> makes technical revisions and provides that prescription monitoring information may only be used in a manner consistent with <u>present law</u>.
