- "Section 3. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Act which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or applications, and to this end the provisions of this Act are hereby declared severable.
- Section 4. (A) The provisions of R.S. 40:1061.1.3(G) as enacted by Section 1 of this Act shall apply only to offenses committed after August 1, 2019.
- (B) Section 3, this Section, and the provisions of R.S. 40:1061.1.3(G) as enacted by Section 1 of this Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, Section 3, this Section, and the provisions of R.S.

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1 40:1061.1.3(G) as enacted by Section 1 of this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval."

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
