Rule 11.4. Floor amendments; public information; copies

B. A copy of each a proposed floor amendment which is no more than one page, except amendments an amendment proposed by the chairman of the Legislative Bureau on behalf of the Legislative Bureau, shall be placed on the desk of each member of the House who so requests has notified the Clerk that the member wants to receive printed copies of all proposed floor amendments, and no vote shall be taken on such the proposed floor amendment until this requirement has been met.

A copy of each proposed floor amendment which is two or more pages, except amendments proposed by the chairman of the Legislative Bureau on behalf of the Legislative Bureau, shall be placed on the desk of each member of the House, unless the member notifies the Clerk otherwise, and no vote shall be taken on such proposed floor amendment until this requirement has been met.

Abstract: Provides that a member must request copies of floor amendments.

<u>Present House Rule</u> provides that a copy of each proposed floor amendment which is no more than one page, except amendments proposed on behalf of the Legislative Bureau, shall be placed on the desk of each member of the House who so requests, and no vote shall be taken on the amendment until this requirement has been met.

<u>Proposed House Rule</u> provides that a copy of a proposed floor amendment shall be placed on the desk of each member of the House who has notified the Clerk that the member wants to receive printed copies of all proposed floor amendments. Otherwise retains <u>present House</u> Rule.

<u>Present House Rule</u> provides that a copy of each proposed floor amendment which is two or more pages, except amendments proposed by the Legislative Bureau, shall be placed on the desk of each member of the House unless the member notifies the Clerk otherwise, and no vote shall be taken on the amendment until this requirement has been met.

Proposed House Rule repeals present House Rule.

Effective January 13, 2020.

The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on House and Governmental Affairs</u> to the <u>original</u> resolution:

1. Provide that <u>proposed House Rule</u> becomes effective Jan. 13, 2020.
