Requests the Dept. of Economic Development, with the La. Assoc. of Business and Industry, to create a task force to study and conduct a beta test of the Cybersecurity Framework Standards promulgated by the National Institute of Standards and Technology and to provide a written report of its findings and recommendations to the House Committee on Commerce; the Senate Committee on Commerce, Consumer Protection, and International Affairs; the House Committee on Ways and Means; and the Senate Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs no later than Jan. 10, 2020.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Commerce</u> to the <u>original</u> concurrent resolution:

1. Add two representatives to the task force: the chief executive officer of LCTA- The Internet & Television Association or his designee and the chairman of the Louisiana Telecommunications Association or his designee.

The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on House and Governmental</u> <u>Affairs</u> to the <u>engrossed</u> concurrent resolution:

- 1. Provide that each chairman of the specified legislative committees may have a designee serve on the task force in his place.
- 2. Change the report date <u>from</u> no later than 60 days prior to the 2020 R.S. <u>to</u> no later than Jan. 10, 2020.
- 3. Make technical changes.
