HIGHWAYS: Designates a portion of United States Highway 190, Gause Boulevard West, as the "Officer Jason Seals Memorial Highway"

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

- 1. Makes technical changes.
- 2. Removes the requirement that the Dept. of Transportation and Development or its contractors erect and maintain appropriate signage reflecting the memorial highway designation.
- 3. Directs the Dept. of Transportation and Development to erect and maintain appropriate signage reflecting the designations provided local or private monies are received by the department equal to the actual cost for material, fabrication, mounting posts, and installation of each sign, not to exceed the sum of \$550 per sign.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Designates the portion of U.S. Hwy. 190 from Northshore Blvd. to U.S. Hwy. 11 in Slidell, La. as the "Officer Jason Seals Memorial Highway".

Directs the Dept. of Transportation and Development to erect and maintain appropriate signage reflecting the highway designation provided local or private monies are received by the department equal to the actual cost for material, fabrication, mounting posts, and installation of each sign, not to exceed \$550 per sign.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The House Floor Amendments to the engrossed bill:

1. Designate the portion of U.S. Hwy 171 from Kings Hwy. to Midway Ave. in Shreveport, La. as the "Ralph D. Balentine Memorial Highway".
