23 actually include the making of arrests, the performing of searches and  
24 seizures, or the execution of criminal warrants, and who is responsible for the  
25 prevention or detection of crime or for the enforcement of the penal, traffic,  
26 or highway laws of this state."

33 "(4) "Verbal or written communication" means any textual, visual,  
34 written, or oral communication, including communications made through
