Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Requests that the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections study laws and policies relative to benefits, including sick leave, for teachers at facilities under the jurisdiction of the office of juvenile justice who are injured or disabled as a result of assault or battery while acting in their official capacity and submit a written report of findings and conclusions, including any recommendations for related legislation, to the House Committee on the Administration of Criminal Justice and the Senate Committee on Judiciary B not later than 60 days prior to the beginning of the 2020 R.S.
