Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, prescription shall not be considered to have accrued until two years from the date of receipt of the Department of Defense notice issued to the taxpayer pursuant to the provisions of the federal law for any period in which the taxpayer received a refund from the Internal Revenue Service concerning an adjustment to income pursuant to the provisions of the Combat-Injured Veterans Tax Fairness Act of 2016. This prescriptive period is limited to the corresponding Louisiana income tax refund. A taxpayer may claim this Louisiana refund by amending the Louisiana individual income tax return for the same period in which a federal income tax refund was granted pursuant to the Combat-Injured Veterans Tax Fairness Act of 2016. Alternatively, a taxpayer may claim a Louisiana standard refund amount proportional to that of the federal standard refund amount in accordance with rules promulgated by the secretary in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act.
