2	To amend and reenact R.S. 17:173(A)(2)(introductory paragraph), (B), and (C), relative to
3	behavioral health services for students; to provide relative to applied behavior
4	analysis services provided to students when requested by parents or legal guardians;
5	to provide for definitions; to provide for related policies adopted by public school
6	governing authorities; and to provide for related matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 17:173(A)(2)(introductory paragraph), (B), and (C) are hereby
9	amended and reenacted to read as follows:
10	§173. Behavioral health services for students

13	(2) Not later than January 1, 2019, each Each public school governing
14	authority shall adopt and make available to the public a policy to implement the
15	provisions of this Section and such policy, at a minimum, shall provide that:
16	* * *
17	B. For purposes of this Section, the following terms shall have the following
18	meanings:

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1	(1) "Applied behavior analysis provider" shall mean a provider who is
2	licensed, certified, or registered by the Louisiana Behavior Analyst Board and is in
3	good standing to provide applied behavior analysis services.
4	(2) "Applied behavior analysis services" shall include the design,
5	implementation, and evaluation of systematic instructional and environmental
6	modifications by an applied behavior analysis provider to produce socially
7	significant improvements in behavior as described in the Behavior Analyst Practice
8	<u>Act.</u>
9	(1)(3) "Behavioral health evaluation" shall include but not be limited to the
10	following criteria:
11	(a) Diagnosis.
12	(b) Type of intervention.
13	(c) Length of intervention.
14	(d) Identification of a student's goals.
15	(e) Identification of impact of student behavior on a student's educational
16	program.
17	(f) Recommendations for applied behavior analysis services.
18	(2)(4) "Behavioral health provider" shall mean a provider who is licensed by
19	the Louisiana Department of Health or a health profession licensing board and is in
20	good standing to provide behavioral health services in Louisiana including but not
21	limited to a psychiatrist, psychologist, medical psychologist, licensed specialist in
22	school psychology, marriage and family therapist, professional counselor, clinical
23	social worker, applied behavior analysis provider, or a behavioral health provider
24	organization licensed to provide behavioral health services in Louisiana.
25	(3)(5) "Behavioral health services" shall include but not be limited to
26	individual psychotherapy, family psychotherapy, psychotropic medication
27	management, community psychiatric support and treatment, and crisis intervention,
28	and medically necessary applied behavior analysis services.
29	(4)(6) "Evaluator" shall mean a licensed psychiatrist, psychologist, medical
30	psychologist, licensed specialist in school psychology, professional counselor,

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1	marriage and family therapist, or clinical social worker, or applied behavior analysis
2	provider who is certified by the respective board of examiners in Louisiana to
3	provide necessary evaluations and who is not an employee of the public school
4	governing authority or the state Department of Education.
5	C. Nothing in this Section shall be construed to supersede any of the
6	following:
7	(1) the The authority of a student's Individualized Education Program team
8	or Section 504 committee to determine appropriate services for a student pursuant
9	to applicable federal and state law.
10	(2) The provisions of the Behavioral Health Services Provider Licensing
11	Law or any regulation promulgated by the Louisiana Department of Health pursuant
12	to that law.
13	(3) The provisions of the Behavior Analyst Practice Act.
