1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact R.S. 34:851.32(A)(1), (B), and (C) and R.S. 56:10.2, relative to boat
3	registration; to provide for the Derelict Houseboat Fund Account and the
4	Conservation Fund in the state treasury; to provide for the distribution of boat
5	registration fees; to provide for the use of funds; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 34:851.32(A)(1), (B), and (C) are hereby amended and reenacted to
8	read as follows:
9	§851.32. Disposition of funds
10	A.(1) Funds accruing to the state of Louisiana from registration fees paid by
11	owners of motorboats and sailboats shall be paid into the state treasury and shall be
12	credited to the Bond Security and Redemption Fund. Out of the funds remaining in
13	the Bond Security and Redemption Fund, after a sufficient amount is allocated from
14	that fund to pay all obligations secured by the full faith and credit of the state which
15	become due and payable within any fiscal year, the treasurer shall, prior to placing
16	such remaining funds in the State General Fund, pay into the Derelict Houseboat
17	Conservation Fund of the Louisiana Wildlife and Fisheries Commission an amount
18	equal to the total amount, less the amounts provided in Paragraph (2) of this
19	Subsection, of the sums recovered as registration fees for motorboat and sailboat
20	registrations in R.S. 34:851.20 and 851.23 of this Part for the purpose of

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administering and enforcing the provisions of this Part or for such other purposes as may be determined by said commission.

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B. The revenues derived from the registration fees paid into the <del>Derelict</del> Houseboat <u>Conservation</u> Fund pursuant to Subsection A of this Section shall be made available for the purpose of providing the necessary additional funds for the administration and enforcement of the provisions of this Part or for such other purposes as may be determined by the Louisiana Wildlife and Fisheries Commission.

9 C. Funds accruing to the state of Louisiana from registration the fees paid by owners for the registration of houseboats shall be paid into the state treasury and 10 11 shall be credited to the Bond Security and Redemption Fund. Out of the funds 12 remaining in the Bond Security and Redemption Fund, after a sufficient amount is 13 allocated from that fund to pay all obligations secured by the full faith and credit of 14 the state which become due and payable within any fiscal year, the treasurer shall 15 pay into the Derelict Houseboat Fund Account an amount equal to the total amount 16 of the sums recovered as registration fees for houseboat registrations in R.S. 17 34:851.20 of this Part.

18 Section 2. R.S. 56:10.2 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

19 §10.2. Derelict Houseboat Fund Account

20 There is hereby created a fund special statutorily dedicated fund account 21 within the state treasury known as the "Derelict Houseboat Fund Account" which 22 shall consist of those revenues collected from the registration of houseboats provided 23 for in R.S. 34:851.32(C). The revenues shall be subject to the same requirements as 24 provided for other revenues placed in the Conservation Fund in Paragraph (1) of this 25 Subsection. Subject to legislative appropriation, The the monies in this fund the 26 account shall be used solely for the purpose of awarding grants to parish 27 governments to remove any unattended, derelict, junked, or abandoned houseboat 28 in any canal, coulee, drainage ditch, outfall canal, bayou, bay, lake, or any other 29 waterway, whether navigable or not, or on the banks thereof within the state of 30 Louisiana. An amount not to exceed ten percent of the annual appropriation may be

1	used for the administration and enforcement of this Section and Part IV of Chapter
2	<u>4 of Title 34 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950.</u> The Louisiana Wildlife and
3	Fisheries Commission may promulgate rules and regulations in accordance with the
4	Administrative Procedure Act to provide for the application, administration, and
5	award of such grants. Monies deposited into the account shall be categorized as fees
6	and self-generated revenue for the sole purpose of reporting related to the executive
7	budget, supporting documents, and general appropriation bills.
