1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact R.S. 17:236.3, relative to school attendance; to authorize city, parish,
3	and other local public school boards and chartering authorities to adopt policies
4	providing for student attendance at virtual schools for purposes related to habitual
5	absence or tardiness; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 17:236.3 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
8	§236.3. Virtual School; definition; attendance policies
9	<u>A.</u> "Virtual school" means a public school, including a charter school, which
10	has a unique site code assigned by the state Department of Education and which
11	delivers all or a majority of the instruction provided through the internet or other
12	electronic medium such that a student is not necessarily required to be at a specific
13	location in order to receive instruction from a teacher. This does not preclude the
14	ability of the school to include traditional classroom-based instruction or to host
15	face-to-face meetings, including field trips, extracurricular activities, conferences
16	between a student, parents, and teachers, or other related activities or events.
17	However, a school that delivers all or a majority of the instruction provided through
18	the internet or other electronic medium and requires students to be in daily
19	attendance at a specified location to receive such instruction shall not be considered
20	a virtual school.

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CODING: Words in struck through type are deletions from existing law; words <u>underscored</u> are additions.

1	B.(1) Each city, parish, or other local public school board may adopt a policy
2	that defines attendance at a virtual school for purposes of compliance with R.S.
3	<u>17:233.</u>
4	(2) Each chartering authority may adopt in policy or include in charter
5	agreements a definition of attendance at a virtual charter school which may include
6	provisions for addressing excessive absences, such as parental notification, student
7	engagement and withdrawal from the school for failure to engage, and referrals to
8	child welfare and attendance officers and family and juvenile courts.
