## **ACT No. 87**

HOUSE BILL NO. 120

## BY REPRESENTATIVE BOURRIAQUE

To transfer any monies remaining in the Shrimp Trade Petition Account into the Shrimp
Marketing and Promotion Fund; and to provide for related matters.
Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of R.S. 56:305(H), the state treasurer shall
transfer any monies remaining in the Shrimp Trade Petition Account into the Shrimp
Marketing and Promotion Fund. Once transferred into the Shrimp Marketing and Promotion
Fund, the monies shall be used only for the purposes outlined in law for the Shrimp
Marketing and Promotion Fund.
Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
effective on the day following such approval.
