2	To enact R.S. 17:71.2(D), relative to the size of school boards; to provide with regard to the
3	maximum and minimum size of certain school boards; and to provide for related
4	matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 17:71.2(D) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
7	§71.2. Maximum and minimum size of boards; four-year concurrent terms
8	* * *
9	D. Notwithstanding the provisions of Subsection A of this Section or any
10	law to the contrary, in accomplishing the reapportionment authorized by this
11	Subpart, a school board in a parish with a population of between ninety thousand
12	and one hundred five thousand persons according to the most recent decennial census
13	shall, by majority vote of the board as presently constituted, reestablish itself with
14	not less than five nor more than nine members. Whenever the size of a school board
15	is to be changed by reapportionment, the school board may submit the proposition
16	of size to the people.
