| 6 | Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: |
| 7 | Section 1. R.S. 32:408.1(A)(3) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows: |
| 8 | §408.1. Third-party testing; proof of testing |
| 9 | A. The Department of Public Safety and Corrections, public safety services, |
| 10 | may contract with or license another state, an employer, a private driver training |
| 11 | facility, driver education course provider, or other private institution, or a |
| 12 | department, agency, or instrumentality of a local government to administer the skills |
| 13 | tests as specified herein if all of the following conditions are met: |

| 15 | (3) The third party has a contract or license with the department to |
| 16 | administer skills tests for Class "A", "B", or "C" driver's licenses which, at minimum, |

complies with 49 CFR 383.75. In addition, the third-party tester must initiate and maintain a surety bond in the amount of ten forty thousand dollars.
