<u>Prior law</u> required an applicant for the certified medication attendant drug administration training course to be a citizen of the United States and a resident of Louisiana. <u>New law</u> clarifies and expands the citizenship requirement to allow for a citizen of the United States, a United States national, or an alien lawfully admitted for permanent residency in the United States. <u>New law</u> repeals the state residency requirement. <u>New law</u> retains the additional eligibility requirements for acceptance into the drug administration course set forth in <u>prior</u> law.

New law makes technical corrections to the eligibility requirements retained from prior law.

Effective August 1, 2019.
