Armes

Existing law prohibits a person holding a retail dealer's permit, and any agent, associate, employee, representative, or servant of such person, to do or permit certain acts on or about the licensed premises.

New law extends the application of the existing law prohibitions to persons permitted to sell alcoholic beverages at retail to consumers.

Existing law further provides for a list of certain types of identification to be used for verifying the age of persons when selling or serving alcoholic beverages.

New law retains the existing law list and authorizes the use of a real-time age verification system authorized by the commissioner of ATC to verify the age of persons when selling or serving alcoholic beverages.

Effective August 1, 2019.
